First Holy Communion: The programme has restarted with children learning at home with their textbooks, assisted by some accompanying videos by Fr Richard. The children can receive their First Communion at St Joseph's at either the morning Mass on Saturday 10th October, or the morning Mass on Sunday 11th October. First Confessions will take place on Saturday 3rd September. Please keep all the children in your prayers as they prepare to receive Our Blessed Lord for the first time.

Mass time changes: Please note that the morning Mass in Richmond is now at 10am on a permanent basis. Also, the Sunday Mass in Leyburn will be on Saturday evening at 5pm this weekend and next weekend (Sep 12th-13th). A reminder that the Bishops' suspension of the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday is still in place. There will be no Saturday evening confessions in Richmond for the next two weeks. Confessions are always available upon request.

Ongoing Catechises: People of secondary school age upwards are still very welcome to join the "distance learning" Journey in Faith course which follows the themes of the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*.
